Bible Time:

Let's talk about it:

The soldiers gave Jesus a robe and a crown. But they did it to mock him. Mocking is a mean kind of teasing. What was the crown made of? (thorns)

How do you think that felt on his head? (bad, it hurt)

What were some of the other mean things they did to Jesus? (whipped, spat)

How do you think that made Jesus feel? (sad, bad, mad)

Why do you think they did that to Jesus, the King of heaven and earth? (they didn't understand who he was and why he came)

Why did he come? (to rescue them and us)

Jesus had to carry that big, heavy cross up a hill. Then the soldiers nailed him to it. What did Jesus ask his Father to do to those men? (to forgive them)

Could Jesus have come down from the cross if he wanted to rescue himself? (yes)

Why do you suppose he didn't do that? (He wanted to rescue us instead)

What happened to the sky after Jesus died? (it got dark)
Jesus' friends carried him to a tomb carved out of rock. What did the soldiers put in front of the tomb? (a big stone)

They thought that was the end of Jesus. What do you think?
